

WELCOME TO UZBEKISTAN



Tashkent City: is a business center under construction in Tashkent. Located in the Shayxontoxur district, between Alisher Navoi Avenue, Olmazor, Furkat streets and Islam Karimov Avenue.

Within the framework of the Tashkent City IBC, a business activity zone is being created that will unite business, residential apartments and leisure. The managing company of the Tashkent City IBC project is the Tashkent City Directorate. Construction is being carried out on the site of the demolished managing (paighborhoods) of

the demolished mahallas (neighborhoods) of Olmazor and Ukchi, on a territory with a total

area of 80 hectares. This is the largest construction project in Uzbekistan. The construction of the project is carried out with financial investments from private investors.

The commercial concept of the project was developed by the American company Cushman & Wakefield.

Of the 8 projects for the future business center, the concept proposed by the Turkish architectural company Tabanlıoğlu Architects was chosen.

History Plans for the creation of the Tashkent City business center were first publicly announced by the candidate for the post of President of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev on November 24, 2016 during a meeting with voters in Tashkent as part of the election campaign.

Work to prepare the concept of an international business center took 8 months. As a result, out of 7 concepts presented, 2 were taken as the basis for the project.

On July 28, 2017, a government decree was

adopted on the creation of the Tashkent City IBC. The directorate for the construction of the complex was subsequently headed by Jakhongir Artikkhodjayev.

Construction work began in October 2017, at which time it became known about planned demolitions at the site of the future complex.

As a result, the following buildings were demolished:

residential buildings that have been resettled since 2015 in the "Ukchi" and "Olmazor" neighborhoods;

the building of the Republican Cinema House, built in 1982 according to the design of the architect Rafael Khairutdinov;

the Tashkent Metro administration building (the enterprise is located on the same street in a 9-story building); the building of the Main Directorate of Migration and Registration of Citizenship of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Uzbekistan;

the building of the Republican Center for Children's Art "Barkamol Avlod" (formerly the Palace of Pioneers and Schoolchildren named after V.I. Lenin); banquet hall



WELCOME TO UZBEKISTAN

Bukhara (Uzb. Buxoro) is one of the oldest cities in Central Asia, the administrative center of the Bukhara region of Uzbekistan; architectural and historical-cultural zapovednik, sokhranivshii unique pamyatniki zodchestva all historical epoch, nachinaya s IX veka. V razvitoe srednevekove ona byla focussing culture, science and Muslim theology of the entire Middle and Middle East.

Bukhara is a unique city in Central Asia, whose pre- and early Islamic history was described in detail in the well-known work Narshahi, istorika, living in the 10th century.



Bukhara was the capital of the Bukhara Khanate, the capital of the Timurid Empire, and the capital of various ruling dynasties, the Bukhara People's Soviet Republic and the Uzbek SSR.



Samarkand (Uzbek: Samarqand) is the third most populous city in Uzbekistan, the administrative center of the Samarkand region.

The total area of the city is 123.82 km². The population as of January 1, 2023 was 573.2 thousand; in 2022, it was planned to expand the city's territory (it would have been 284.15 km²) and increase its population due to suburban areas. At the end of December 2022, the President of Uzbekistan announced that as soon

as the population of Samarkand approaches one million, the city will be separated from the Samarkand region and will receive the status of a city of republican subordination, which previously only had the capital of Uzbekistan, Tashkent.

The city is located at an altitude of about 720 meters above sea level. The historical center of the city is the Registan square and ensemble.

In 2001, the city and its historical architectural and archaeological monuments were included in the UNESCO World Heritage List under the title "Samarkand - Crossroads of Cultures".















WELCOME TO UZBEKISTAN

Khiva (Uzbek: Xiva) is a city in the Khorezm region of Uzbekistan, the administrative center of the Khiva region. The last capital of Khorezm. In 1997, Khiva celebrated its 2500th anniversary.

Surrounded by powerful walls, the historical inner city of Khiva - the pearl of the Khorezm oasis - has been declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO.

A later legend about the founding of the city tells that it grew up around the well of Heivak,

the water from which had an amazing taste, and the well was dug by order of Shem, the son of the biblical Noah. This well can still be seen today in the old quarter of Khiva, Ichan-Kale.

Khiva was one of the cities of ancient Khorezm, which was a large state located in the west of Central Asia, south of the Aral Sea.



Shakhrisabz (Uzbek: Shahrisabz) is a city in the Kashkadarya region (vilayat) of Uzbekistan. One of the oldest cities in Central Asia until the 16th century, known as Kesh. Shakhrisabz is located between the tributaries of the Kashkadarya Oksuv river in the north and Tankhazdarya in the south. The population as of January 1, 2014 is 100.3 thousand inhabitants, in 1991 - 53 thousand inhabitants. The majority of the population are Uzbeks. There is an airport and a railway station called Kitab, which in 1959 ceased to be an independent unit of the Shakhrisabz region and became part of the city

of Shakhrisabz. The name of the city Shakhrisabz comes from the Persian (shahr) "city" and (sabz) "green" and is literally translated as "Green City", "Zelenograd".

This name stuck to the city starting from the 15th century. Until the 15th century, the city was known under the Sogdian name Kesh (Sogdian Koš) with the meaning "dwelling, house, settlement." In "Babur-Nama" (XV - early XVI centuries), along with the name Kesh, Shakhrisabz was also used.
